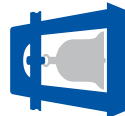

# The 40th Joanne Winter Arizona Silver Belle Championship

The Joanne Winter Arizona Silver Belle Championship is nationally recognized and open to all qualified young women amateur golfers, ages 13 through 23. Entrants must meet age requirements as of Dec. 28, 2010. The tournament consists of 54 holes of stroke play, gross score, 18 holes each day. The Silver Belle Championship is a TITEIST/GOLF WEEK MAGAZINE points tournament.

## Eligibility/Field

Entrants MUST provide a USGA Handicap Index of 15.0 or lower. Visit the website at [www.azsilverbelle.com](http://www.azsilverbelle.com) and supply a resume of tournament scores and other information as required by the golf registration system. The selection process is based upon this information, national ranking and handicap.

The field will be limited to 112 golfers based on all information with age considerations, not according to entry receipt date. The field will be flighted according to age: 13-14, 15-16, 17-18 and 19-23. The overall winner may come from any age group.

## Practice Round

Each player is responsible for making her own tee time for the practice round to be held between 8 and 10 a.m. on Monday, Dec. 27, off the first and 10th tees. Players should call the Pro Shop at the ASU Karsten Golf Course 480-921-8070 from Nov. 27-Dec. 17 to secure a practice round tee time. Only tournament players may play during the practice round time period. Please identify yourself as an Arizona Silver Belle Championship participant.

## Entries

Confirmation of acceptance will be E-mailed on Oct. 18, 2010. The entry fee of \$250 includes greens fees for the Dec. 27 practice round, tournament greens fees, players' dinner and the practice balls before and after each tournament round. All participants must have registered in person by 5 p.m., Dec. 27 at ASU Karsten Golf Course or must have advised a tournament official of their time of arrival. **Absolutely no refunds will be made after Nov. 15.**

## Miscellaneous Information

**Pace of Play** – USGA Rule 6-7, Note 2 will be strictly enforced.

**Caddies** – NO CADDIES or golf carts WILL BE PERMITTED. Golfers must walk and carry their own bags. Pull carts may be used but must be provided by the individual golfer.

**Conduct of Play** – USGA Rules of Golf will apply. Contestants are expected to wear proper golf attire. Spectators MUST follow in the rough and shall not distract players. Spectators who do not comply will be asked to leave the golf course.

**Awards** – The champion will be determined from the entire field. In the event of a tie for the championship, the winner shall be determined by a sudden death playoff. All other ties shall be determined according to USGA guidelines. Medalist will be awarded over the field on the first day of play. Prizes will be awarded by flights.
